INTRODUCTION

Living in Kununurra

As the gateway to Western Australia's magnificent Kimberley region, Kununurra is the heart of a bustling community supported by agriculture, tourism and mining industries. Located in the East Kimberley, the picturesque town takes its name from a local aboriginal word meaning "meeting of the big waters" and is home to around 6,000 residents.

In the early 1960's the Ord River was dammed to create the Ord River Irrigation Scheme with Lake Argyle and Lake Kununurra also being formed. These lakes and associated waterways now service a broad range of agricultural ventures and are a paradise for fishing, boating and outdoor enthusiasts.

Created as the centre for the irrigation scheme, Kununurra has well developed infrastructure including a modern hospital, leisure and aquatic centre, shopping centre and specialty shops.

By road, the town is situated 3200km from Perth and 800km from Darwin, with the closest town, Wyndham, located 100km to the north. To the east, the Western Australia/Northern Territory border is a mere 30km away.

CLIMATE

Weather and Climate

Kununurra has a tropical monsoonal climate with two distinct seasons. The 'wet' season usually occurs from about October to April when most of the annual rainfall occurs and maximum temperatures increase into the 40's. The rest of the year is known as the 'dry' season that is typified by clear blue skies with day temperatures of low 30's, relatively cool evenings and brilliant sunsets.

Fishing

Keen anglers are in their element living in Kununurra where they are blessed with some of the best fishing in Australia. A large boating and fishing community enjoy Lake Argyle, Lake Kununurra and the Ord River as well as many other local rivers across the East Kimberley including the Pentecost, King, Durack, Drysdale, Dunham, and Keep Rivers. The Ord River is especially popular due to its proximity to Kununurra where fishing opportunities abound in both the tidal and freshwater sections of the rivers. The mighty barramundi is highly sought after along the lower parts of the Ord River downstream from the Diversion Dam, with best catches occurring during the wet season.

Holidays and festivals

Initiated in January 2000 by the Chamber of Commerce and Industry, the Ord Valley Muster (www.ordvalleymuster.com.au) has become a popular annual event. Over two busy weeks in May each year, it celebrates the character of the Ord Valley and showcases the area's heritage and culture. The Kimberley Moon Experience is the 'jewel in the crown' of the festival with its grand opening concert. While picnicking on the banks of the Ord River, attendees enjoy a balmy, dry season evening of music and entertainment. With ever increasing crowd numbers, its already a permanent highlight, and is starting to attract interstate and national attention.

Other past year's events of the Muster have included something for everyone – Paddy's Market's Theme Days, Celebrity Tree Park Sunset Experience and Hash House Harriers Muster Dash. For something with a little more 'culture' - Australian Movie Night, and Wine and Cheese Art Appreciation, Musicals in Hidden Valley National Park, Kununurra District High School Annual Fete and Zebra Rock Open Day. Also some fun, action packed activities - Mud Footy Match, Rotary 4WD

Rally, The Wyndham Adventure Tour, Ord Valley Muster Rodeo, Dam to Dam boat race, and Ord-side dance party to international DJs.

National Parks

Managed by the Department of Conservation and Land Management (CALM), four national parks are within the vicinity of Kununurra. Part of CALM's aim is to ensure that visitors to the national parks leave with positive memories of what they have seen and heard, and this is visible in the care with which they are maintained. Mirima National Park

Easy walking distance from the centre of Kununurra, the Mirima National Park (Hidden Valley) features sandstone cliffs similar to that of the famous Bungle Bungles. The age of the formations are said to be around 300 million years old and are particularly eye catching at sunrise and sunset.

Drysdale National Parks

Due to the remote location of this huge national park (430, 000 hectares) unfortunately it is difficult to access. Those lucky enough to have visited it say it is "wild, untouched and very beautiful".

Prince Regent River Nature Reserve

Being a member of a charter boat group is the best way to view this also remote

national park that covers an expansive 630,000 hectares. UNESCO has recognised the significance of this reserve by granting it “World Biosphere Reserve” status.

Parry Lagoons Nature Reserve

Less than an hour’s drive from Kununurra, this bird watcher’s paradise is regarded as a wetland of international significance. In addition to 17 species of duck, a vast array of magpie geese, swamp hens, cranes, dabchicks, pelicans, brolga and jabiru can be observed. Walking tracks are well marked and binoculars are a must to gain a close-up of the fascinating wildlife. The best time to visit is during the dry season.
